A patient visits to discuss her blood results. She did her yearly, complete blood examination last week, as usual. When discussing the results, you discover an elevated TSH. The lady has no symptoms, except for nonspecific complaints such as fatigue and mild gain of weight. How would you go further with this?

2. Infographic Prostate cancer screening with prostate-specific antigen (PSA) test
